- 3. Acceptance to 4 or 5 year college or university
- 4. A recent copy of high school transcript (minimum 3.2 GPA required)
- 5. Two letters of recommendation
- 6. A one-page response to the following topic: How has your participation in Cross Country and/or Track and Field positively affected your life and how do you see it influencing your future?
